

Notice of Veteran's Preference

Leon County gives preference in appointment to eligible veterans and family members as defined in Chapter 295, Laws of Florida.

Eligibility Criteria & Required Documents

Eligibility criteria for veterans' preference and a list of required documents can be found on the [Florida Department of Veterans' Affairs \(FDVA\) website](#).

Claiming Preference

When claiming veterans' preference, you must:

- Complete the veterans' preference section of the job application;
- Submit veterans' preference documentation at the time of application submission.

Preference will not be awarded unless the documentation is completed. Documents that arrive more than 5 business days after the job application submission will not be accepted.

Do not submit originals as documents cannot be returned. Copies should be marked to show the job posting title and the veterans' preference status you are claiming.
