Vote-by-Mail Ballot Data Request

Vote-by-mail ballot request information is confidential and exempt from public disclosure under 101.62(2), F. S., except to statutorily designed persons or entities who may obtain and use it for political purposes only.

An online account authorizing access is only valid for one election cycle. The online account automatically expires at the end of the election year in which it is issued, or if you are no longer eligible to access the information. If you wish to receive access in subsequent election years, you will have to reapply. .

If you want to access these files, you must first complete the form below. We will then review your application and provide you with login information to an online portal where you can download the files.

Access to the files is only available during the reporting period: 60 days before the election through 15 days after the election. Files include data for all voters in Leon County who have requested a Vote-by-Mail ballot. You can sort/filter the data for specific districts or parties.
