You must register for a class. Walk-ins may not be granted entry due to seating limitations.

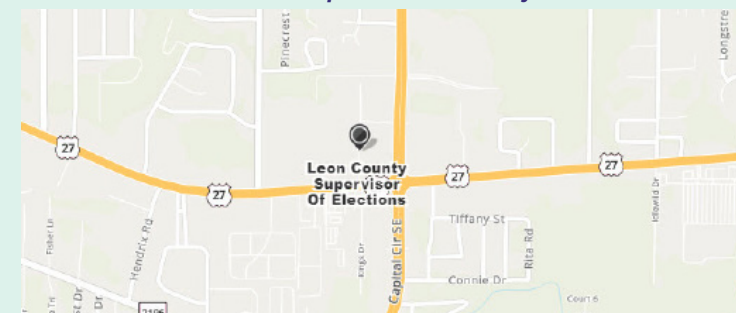

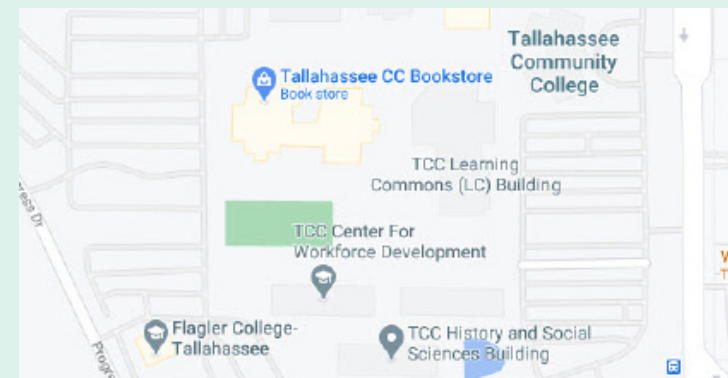

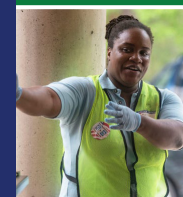
