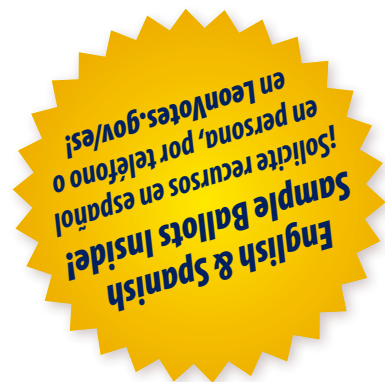

# Voter Registration

If you were registered to vote in Florida by the October 11 registration deadline, you can vote in the General Election. Verify your voting information for this election using any of these options:

- Visit [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov), click the “Your Voter Info” button, and enter your information. Here, you can view your sample ballot, see Early Voting dates and sites, request or check on the status of your Vote-by-Mail ballot, and see your Election Day polling place.
- Check your Voter Information Card. Your precinct number is the 4-digit number listed under your name and address on the front of the card. Your polling place and party affiliation are also listed on the card.
- Call our office at (850) 606-8683 Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 5 pm. We can help you verify your voting information.

### **Need to update your voter registration address?**

Visit [RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov](http://RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov) to update your information online quickly and securely.

### **Has your signature changed over time?**

If so, you need to update your signature with our office. Contact us and we will send you a voter registration application you can use to update your signature.



# How to Vote

## 1 Vote-by-Mail

Request a Vote-by-Mail ballot. See the “Vote-by-Mail” section of this guide for details.

## 2 Early Voting

Early Voting makes voting in person easy and convenient. Our 10 Early Voting sites are open Monday, October 24, through Sunday, November 6. Voting hours vary by location, check the “Early Voting” section of this guide for details.

## 3 On Election Day

Election Day is your last chance to vote! Voting hours are 7 am to 7 pm on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. You must vote at your assigned polling place.

To verify your voter information before you vote, visit [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov) and click *Your Voter Info*, or call (850) 606-8683 Monday through Friday 8:30 am to 5 pm.

All voters waiting in line at 7 pm will have the opportunity to vote.





# Early Voting

**Monday, October 24<sup>th</sup> – Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup>**

Early Voting in Leon County is open to all voters. Early Voting lets you avoid long lines, vote when it is easy for you, and choose between 10 different locations in Leon County. **Make sure to bring valid ID!** Visit [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov) or call (850) 606-8683 to confirm dates and times.

# Vote-by-Mail

Requesting a Vote-by-Mail ballot is easy! All voters in Florida have the option to vote by mail.

**Online:** Visit [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov) and click "Vote-by-Mail".

**By phone:** Call (850) 606-8683 Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 5 pm.

**In person:** Visit our office at 2990-1 Apalachee Parkway, Tallahassee, FL 32301 to pick up your ballot in person. Or, starting on October 30, you may designate someone to pick up a ballot on your behalf from our office or an Early Voting site during voting hours.

**The deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot be mailed to you is 5 pm Saturday, October 29, 2022.**

If you miss this deadline, you still have the option to pick up a Vote-by-Mail ballot through Election Day.

**TRACK YOUR BALLOT:** You can track the status of your Vote-by-Mail ballot at [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov). Click on the "Your Voter Info" button to view the latest information.

You can sign up to receive notifications about your mail ballot's status at [LeonVotes.gov/BallotTrax](http://LeonVotes.gov/BallotTrax). With BallotTrax, you can receive email or text notifications when your ballot is mailed, when we receive it, and when we count it. The service is completely free for you, and signing up takes just a few minutes.

**RETURNING YOUR BALLOT:** We must receive your ballot by 7 pm on Election Day, November 8. If you choose to mail your ballot, the Post Office recommends that you mail it at least one week before Election Day. Use one First Class "Forever" stamp to mail your ballot.

Instead of using the mail, you may drop off your ballot at any Early Voting site during voting hours in one of our official Vote-by-Mail secure ballot intake stations (*also known as drop boxes*). You can also drop off your ballot at the Elections Office on Monday, November 7th from 8:30 am to 7 pm, and from 7 am to 7 pm on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8.

**Note:** *Vote-by-Mail ballots are **NOT** accepted at polling places on Election Day. However, you can cancel your Vote-by-Mail ballot and instead vote in person.*

**SIGNATURE REVIEW:** Just like in-person voting, we must verify your identity before counting your ballot. We check the signature on your Vote-by-Mail ballot envelope to make sure you sent the ballot. If your signature is missing or does not match our records, we will contact you to fix the issue. You have until 5 p.m. on Thursday, November 10 to fix any signature issues.

**VOTER'S CERTIFICATE: YOU MUST SIGN THIS OATH.**

I, Jane D. Sample, do solemnly swear or affirm that I am a qualified and registered voter of Leon County, Florida, and that I have not and will not vote more than one ballot in this election. I understand that if I commit or attempt to commit any fraud in connection with voting, I can be convicted of a felony of the third degree and fined up to \$5,000, and/or imprisoned for up to 5 years. I also understand that failure to sign this certificate will invalidate my ballot.

# Election Day

## November 8, 2022 is Election Day – your last chance to vote!

If you choose to vote on Election Day, you must cast your ballot at your assigned polling place. Your polling place is based on your precinct (where you live), both are listed on your Voter Information Card. Due to redistricting, you may have a different Election Day polling place this year. Look up your polling place at the end of this guide or online at [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov). For assistance, please call our office at (850) 606-8683 Monday through Friday 8:30 am to 5 pm.



Our office and your polling place will be open 7 am to 7 pm on November 8<sup>th</sup>, Election Day. All voters waiting in line at 7 pm will have the opportunity to cast a ballot. **If you decide to wait until Election Day to vote, please check our website [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov) for any last minute changes that might affect your ability to vote at your normal polling place.**



# Photo and Signature ID

Voting in person at an Early Voting site or on Election Day requires valid photo and signature ID. The photo and signature can come from a single ID or a combination of IDs from the following list:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida Identification Card
- US Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID
- Veteran Health ID issued by the United States Department of Veteran Affairs
- Concealed Weapon / Firearm License issued pursuant to §790.06, F.S.
- Employee ID issued by any branch, department, agency or entity of the Federal Government, the State, a county, or a municipality.



**Your Voter Information Card does not count as valid ID to vote. If you did not bring valid ID to the polls, you can still vote using a Provisional Ballot.**

A **Provisional Ballot** is a backup for a voter who forgets their ID or whose eligibility cannot be verified at the polling site. It allows the Elections Office time to research the voter's eligibility and count the ballot if the voter is eligible.

Some Provisional Ballot voters may need to submit additional information for their ballot to be counted. The deadline to submit this is 5 pm on Thursday, November 10<sup>th</sup>.
