

Leon County, FL - Mark S. Earley, Supervisor of Elections for Leon County, partners with Leon County Government for National Voter Registration Day at all Leon County Public Library <u>locations</u>. On Tuesday, September 19, 2023, the Leon County Supervisor of Elections Office and Leon County Government will join with thousands of other organizations across the country to take part in National Voter Registration Day, a nonpartisan civic holiday that aims to help all eligible voters participate in our democracy.

Registration Day

The national day of action will involve coordinated field, technology, and media efforts to register voters and raise awareness of state-specific registration policies, deadlines, and voting information. "Registering to vote is the first step in casting your ballot," said Supervisor Earley. "This year we are partnering with Leon County Government so that residents will have quick and easy access to in-person voter registration services in their communities at all Leon County Public Library locations. We are also working with engaged FAMU, FSU, and TCC students and organizations to offer voter registration opportunities on campuses. I encourage every eligible Leon County resident to register to vote or confirm your registration as we approach the start of the 2024 Election Cycle."

Voters may register to vote in Florida using any of these methods:

- Online at <u>RegistertoVoteFlorida.gov</u>
- Visit the Leon County Supervisor of Elections Office at 2990-1 Apalachee Parkway
- Visit any <u>Leon County Public Library location</u>
- Speak with Elections Office staff on-site at FAMU, FSU, and TCC
- Mail a voter registration form to PO Box 7357, Tallahassee, FL 32314-7357

Voters who are already registered can confirm their current voter registration information by visiting <u>LeonVotes.gov</u> and clicking the "Your Voter Info" button.

National Voter Registration Day is held each year on a Tuesday in September. Since 2012, over five million voters have registered on the holiday. The event is endorsed by the National Association of Secretaries of State, the National Association of State Election Directors, the U.S. Election Assistance Commission, and the Election Center.
