Leon County Supervisor of Elections Mails Election Guides for 2022 Primary Election

Leon County, FL – Mark S. Earley, Supervisor of Elections for Leon County, announces the mailing of the Official Leon County Election Guides for the 2022 Primary Election. “This week my office will mail the Official Election Guide to each voter in Leon County,” said Supervisor Earley. “The Guide contains the Sample Ballots for the Primary, and is full of other valuable information about where, when, and how voters can cast their ballots in the August 23rd Primary Election. I encourage all voters to read through their Election Guide, so they are prepared to vote in the Primary Election.”

Voters can expect to receive their Election Guide in the mail by the end of this week. Voters can also view or download a copy of the guide from LeonVotes.gov at any time. The guide contains information about the three ways to vote in Florida elections: Vote-by-Mail, Early Voting, and Election Day voting at your polling place. In addition, the guide contains generic sample ballots for voters registered with the democratic or republican parties, as well as the generic non-partisan sample ballot for voters without a major party affiliation. Voters can view their detailed specific sample ballot for their precinct and party affiliation by visiting LeonVotes.gov and clicking on the “Your Voter Info” button.
