**Leon County Supervisor of Elections Provides Election Day Update for 2022 General Election**

**Leon County, FL** – Mark S. Earley, Supervisor of Elections for Leon County provides an Election Day update for the 2022 General Election. “All polling places opened on time this morning at 7 a.m. and will remain open through 7 p.m.,” said Supervisor Earley. “If you have not yet voted in the 2022 General Election, today is the day to make your voice heard! I encourage every registered voter to do your part for our community and vote.”

On Election Day, voters wanting to vote in person need to cast a ballot at their neighborhood polling place. Due to redistricting, some voters have new polling places this year. Voters are encouraged to verify their polling place address before heading to the polls. Voters can find their assigned polling place on their voter information card, online at [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov) by clicking the “Your Voter Info” button, or by calling the Supervisor of Elections Office at (850) 606-8683.

If voters have a mail ballot and have not voted it yet, they can either return it to the Supervisor of Elections Office at 2990-1Apalachee Parkway or choose to vote in person at their Election Day polling place. Remember, Vote-by-Mail ballots must be received by the Election Office by 7 p.m. today<sup>[1]</sup>, or they cannot be counted.

Initial election night results will be posted to [LeonVotes.gov](http://LeonVotes.gov) starting shortly after 7 p.m. Results will be updated throughout the evening as ballots are counted and reported. Although most votes will be counted and reported this evening, Florida elections are always close and elections night results are not final or official. The official tallies will be available Saturday, November 19, when the Leon County Canvassing Board meets to certify the official results for the county.
