Leon County Supervisor of Elections Supports National Voter Registration Day

Leon County, FL – Mark S. Earley, Supervisor of Elections for Leon County, announces support for National Voter Registration Day. On Tuesday, September 20, 2022, the Leon County Supervisor of Elections Office will join with thousands of other election officials across the country to take part in the 10th anniversary celebration of National Voter Registration Day, a nonpartisan civic holiday that aims to help all eligible voters participate in our democracy. The national day of action will involve coordinated field, technology, and media efforts to register voters and raise awareness of state-specific registration policies, deadlines, and voting information. “Registering to vote is the first step in casting your ballot,” said Supervisor Earley. “I encourage every eligible Leon County resident to register to vote or confirm your registration as we approach the November 8 General Election.”

The deadline to register to vote in time for the General Election is October 11. Voters may register to vote in Florida using any of these methods:

- Online at [RegistertoVoteFlorida.gov](https://www.RegistertoVoteFlorida.gov)
- Mail a voter registration form to PO Box 7357, Tallahassee, FL 32314-7357
- Visit the Leon County Supervisor of Elections Office at 2990-1 Apalachee Parkway

Voters who are already registered can confirm their current voter registration information by visiting [LeonVotes.gov](https://www.LeonVotes.gov) and clicking the “Your Voter Info” button.

“Over the last decade, National Voter Registration Day has stood as a testament to the broad-based, bipartisan support for voter registration as the cornerstone of our shared democracy,” said Brian Miller, executive director of the collaborative National Voter Registration Day effort. “As we mark the 10th anniversary of our work to get every eligible American #VoteReady for their next trip to the polls, we’ll continue to depend upon the same grassroots, community based energy that’s made this civic holiday successful year after year.”

National Voter Registration Day is held each year on a Tuesday in September. Since 2012, over 4.7 million voters have registered on the holiday. The holiday has been endorsed by the National Association of Secretaries of State (NASS), the National Association of State Election Directors (NASSED), the U.S. Election Assistance Commission (EAC) and the National Association of Election Officials (The Election Center).
