Leon County Supervisor of Elections Supports Voter Integrity Statement from Statewide Election Association

Leon County, FL – Mark S. Earley, Supervisor of Elections for Leon County, supports the message to voters on election integrity from the statewide association of supervisors of elections. Earlier today, Florida Supervisors of Elections, Inc. (FSE), the statewide association representing all 67 of Florida’s supervisors of elections, issued a statement defending the integrity of Florida elections. “As President-Elect of FSE, I strongly support this statement against election disinformation,” said Supervisor Earley. “Many good people are being led astray by peddlers of this disinformation. Regardless of our differences, we should all share the desire for accessible and accurate elections. The truth is that our laws make it easy to vote and hard to cheat. As an election professional with over 30 years of experience in the field, I can say with the utmost confidence that every voter in our state can trust the integrity of Florida’s elections.”
