## What Do You Know About Voting?

Can I register before I turn 18?  Yes	l'd like to change my political party affiliation. Can I do that?
No You may pre-register at 16. However, you can only vote in Elections that occur on or after your 18th birthday. To register, you must be a U.S. citizen; have your civil rights; and be a legal resident of Florida.	Yes No Submit a completed Florida Voter Registration Application with your new choice. The deadline is 29 days prior to a Primary Election.
