# What Do You Know About Voting?



• **Instructions:** To vote, fill in the oval completely  next to your choice.

**Can I register before I turn 18?**

You may pre-register at 16. However, you can only vote in Elections that occur on or after your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday. To register, you must be a U.S. citizen; have your civil rights; and be a legal resident of Florida.

**Is there a registration deadline?**

It is 29 days prior to Election Day.

**Do I have to register to vote *again* if I have moved within Florida?**

No, but you must update your address into or within Leon County either **online**, **by phone** or **by mail**.

**I am a college student in Leon County. Can I vote here?**

And if you're already registered, just update your address! Many voting precincts are located on or near our local campuses.

Your current name and signature are critical for your vote to count. Submit a completed Florida Voter Registration Application to update your name and/or signature.

Submit a completed Florida Voter Registration Application with your new choice. The deadline is 29 days prior to a Primary Election.

**Can I vote at any Early Voting site before Election Day?**

All eligible voters in Leon County may vote at any Early Voting site. Many voters find this more convenient than voting at their assigned precinct on Election Day.

**Do I need ID to vote?**

In-person voting in Florida requires a valid ID containing a photo and signature. The photo and signature may come from a combination of IDs from the list provided in Florida Statute. **Call us** or **visit [LeonVotes.org](http://LeonVotes.org)** for the complete list. **Note:** If you are not able to produce proper ID, you will be required to vote a **Provisional Ballot**.
