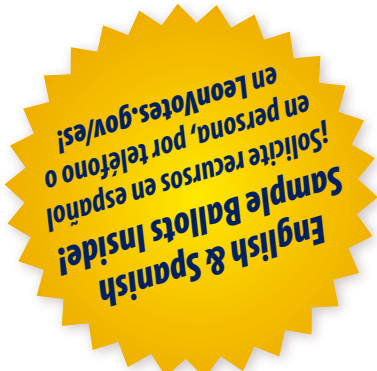

Voter Registration

If you were registered to vote in Florida by the July 25 registration deadline, you are eligible to vote in the Primary Election. Verify your eligibility for this election using any of the following options:

- Visit LeonVotes.gov, click the “Your Voter Info” button, and enter your information. Here, you can view your sample ballot, see Early Voting dates and sites, request or check on the status of your Vote-by-Mail ballot, and see your Election Day polling place.
- Check your Voter Information Card. Your precinct number is the 4-digit number listed under your name and address on the front of the card. Your polling place and party affiliation are also listed on the card.
- Call our office at (850) 606-8683 Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 5 pm. We can help you verify your eligibility.
- Need to update your voter registration address? Visit RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov to update your information online quickly and securely.
- Has your signature changed over time? If so, you need to update your signature with our office. Contact us and we will send you a voter registration application you can use to update your signature.



Vote-by-Mail

Requesting a Vote-by-Mail ballot is easy! All voters in Florida have the option to vote by mail in each election.

Online: Visit LeonVotes.gov and click “Vote-by-Mail”.

By phone: Call (850) 606-8683 Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 5 pm.

In person: Visit our office at 2990-1 Apalachee Parkway, Tallahassee, FL 32301 to pickup your ballot in person. Or, starting on August 14th pick one up for a family member from our office or at an Early Voting site during voting hours.

The deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot to be mailed to you for the Primary Election is 5 pm Saturday, August 13, 2022. If you miss this deadline, you still have the option to pick up a Vote-by-Mail ballot through Election Day.

TRACK YOUR BALLOT: You can track the status of your Vote-by-Mail ballot at LeonVotes.gov. Click on the “Your Voter Info” button to view the latest information.

Starting in 2022, you can sign up to receive notifications about your mail ballot’s status at LeonVotes.gov/BallotTrax. With BallotTrax, you can receive email or text notifications when your ballot is mailed, when we receive it, and when we count it.

The service is completely free for you, and signing up takes just a few minutes.

RETURNING YOUR BALLOT: We must receive your ballot by 7 pm on Election Day, August 23. If you choose to mail your ballot, the Post Office recommends that you mail it at least one week before Election Day.

Instead of relying on the mail, you may drop off your ballot at any Early Voting site during voting hours in one of our official Vote-by-Mail secure ballot intake stations (*also known as drop boxes*).

SIGNATURE REVIEW: Just like in-person voting, we must verify your identity before counting your ballot. We check the signature on your Vote-by-Mail ballot envelope to make sure you sent the ballot. If your signature is missing or does not match our records, we will try and contact you to fix the issue. You have until 5 p.m. on Thursday, August 25 to fix any issues.

Note: *Vote-by-Mail ballots are **NOT** accepted at polling places on Election Day. However, you can cancel your Vote-by-Mail ballot and instead vote in person.*



Early Voting

Saturday, August 13 – Sunday, August 21

Early Voting in Leon County is open to all voters. Early Voting lets you avoid long lines, vote when it is easy for you, and choose between 10 different locations in Leon County. **Make sure to bring valid ID!** Visit LeonVotes.gov or call (850) 606-8683 to confirm dates and times.

Election Day

August 23, 2022 is Election Day – your last chance to vote!

If you choose to vote on Election Day, you must cast your ballot at your assigned polling place. Your polling place is based on your precinct (where you live), both are listed on your Voter Information Card. Due to redistricting, you may have a different Election Day polling place this year. Look up your polling place at the end of this guide or online at LeonVotes.gov. For assistance, please call our office at (850) 606-8683 Monday through Friday 8:30 am to 5 pm.

Our office and your polling place will be open 7 am to 7 pm on August 23, Election Day. All voters waiting in line at 7 pm will have the opportunity to cast a ballot.

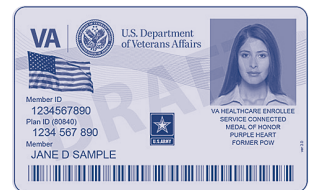
If you decide to wait until Election Day to vote, please check our website LeonVotes.gov for any last minute changes that might affect your ability to vote at your normal polling place.



Photo and Signature ID

Voting in person at an Early Voting site or on Election Day requires valid photo and signature ID. The photo and signature can come from a single ID or a combination of IDs from the following list:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida Identification Card
- US Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID
- Student ID
- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID
- Veteran Health ID issued by the United States Department of Veteran Affairs
- Concealed Weapon / Firearm License issued pursuant to §790.06, F.S.
- Employee ID issued by any branch, department, agency or entity of the Federal Government, the State, a county, or a municipality.



Your Voter Information Card does not count as valid ID to vote. If you did not bring a valid ID to the polls, you can still vote using a Provisional Ballot.

A **Provisional Ballot** is a backup for a voter who forgets their ID or whose eligibility cannot be verified at the polling site. It allows the Elections Office to count the voter's ballot if the voter is eligible.

Some Provisional Ballot voters may need to submit additional eligibility documentation for their ballot to be counted. The deadline to submit this information to the Elections Office is 5 pm on Thursday, August 25.

Voters may track their Provisional Ballot status at LeonVotes.gov or by contacting our office at (850) 606-8683 Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 5 pm.

The importance of our August 23rd Primary Election

This year, all voters, regardless of party affiliation, will have many races and candidates on their Primary Election ballots. The Primary Election is how political parties nominate their candidates for partisan offices, and it often determines the winner of many local nonpartisan contests. Most local offices are nonpartisan in Leon County, and candidates for those offices appear on all voters' ballots, regardless of party affiliation. Voters registered with a political party also get to choose their party nominees for partisan offices. These nominees then go on to the General Election.

Every election cycle, many voters do not cast a ballot in the Primary Election, to the detriment of our community. When you do not vote, you are letting your neighbors decide who speaks for you in government. I strongly urge you to commit to voting in the August 23rd Primary Election and make your voice heard.

Please read through this guide to prepare yourself to vote in the upcoming election. Inside you will find sample ballots, information about the three ways to vote in the election, and more.
